

ELECTRONIC MAIL

E-mail is so clearly superior to paper mail for so many purposes, that most people who try it cannot imagine going back to work without it. E-mail occupies a psychological space all its own. E-mail Advantages

It helps people avoid playing phone tag or coping with paper and stamps. A message can be as simple as a birthday greeting or as complex and lengthy as a report with supporting documents and links to additional online services (including attached video and sound files). It can be quicker than a fax message and more organized than a voice message. By reading the list of senders and topics (subject headings) displayed on the screen, you can quickly decide which messages are important. Also, email software automatically creates an online archive of all sent and received messages. An email message costs as little as a local phone call or less with dialup connection, but it can go across several time zones and be read at any time. Indeed, some email messages are now received as voicemail by the software and can be played back as such.

Email Disadvantages

Nevertheless there are some problems; you might have to sort through scores or even hundreds of messages a day, a form of junk mail brought about by the ease with which anyone can send duplicate copies of a message to many people. Your messages are far from private and may be read by email system operators and others (such as your employer); thus experts recommend you think of email as a postcard rather than a private letter. Mail that travels in the internet often takes a circuitous route, bouncing around various computers in the country, until one of them recognizes the address and delivers the message to its recipient. Thus, although a lot of messages may go through in a minute's time, others may be hung up because of system overload, taking hours and even days. Last, users should not let their email pile up; all these messages may be taking up space on some system's server.
